With a memorable melody and corresponding lyric, it declares the emotional climate of the season. There truly is joy in the world every twenty fifth of December.

You probably didn't know that "Joy to the Word" comes from Psalms 96 & 98, they both read similarly. Psalm 98 reads, "Let the sea resound, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it. Let the rivers clap their hands, let the mountains sing together for joy; let them sing before the Lord, for he comes..."

You probably also didn't know the reason for his coming as stated in those Psalms. Let me pick up Psalm 98 from where we left off, "for he comes to judge the earth." He comes to judge! The people of the earth will be judged by Him! This is what makes another line in the beloved carol so very important, "Let ev'ry heart prepare Him room." This is critical, because if earth is truly going to receive her King then every person must be intentional about making sure there is room in their heart for Him.
