Before I gave my life to the Lord, I found it odd to hear church people call each other "Brother" or "Sister". In the years since that moment in 1980 I have learned to understand how real and precious the "Family of God" truly is.

Being born again has been the greatest blessing in my life. Part of that blessing comes from each of you, my "Brothers" and "Sisters". Thank God for the blessing of family, in all its various forms.
