Contentment

I have enjoyed preaching this recent series of sermons, WHEN LIFE HANDS YOU LEMONS, from the book of Philippians. To take the Apostle Paul's words and investigate them verse by verse has been enlightening and refreshing. As I sit writing this article, I have two sermons left in the series. It probably should have been three more sermons, but hindsight is always 20/20.

The additional sermon I would include, were I ever to preach this series again, would be a complete focus on the second part of chapter 4, verse 12. Philippians 4:12b says, "I have learned the secret of being content..." Pause for dramatic effect... "The secret of being content." Let that phrase rest in the front of your brain for just a few moments. Paul says here that contentment is elusive and that means that not everyone is able to find it. He also says in his first letter to Timothy, "But godliness with contentment is great gain." When I put those two verses together it says to me, "Contentment is a great treasure to be sought out, a secret that is not readily available to all and must be pursued with diligence and dedication."

I once had a man tell me, "I pray for a million dollars every day!" I heard those words and instantly knew I was looking at a frustrated man who, without a change of heart, would be miserable for the rest of his life. He was claiming some message that I find nowhere in my bible. He needed to hear this message from the Apostle Paul instead of the errant message he had been listening to. The message that would have served him well in his life is, "Learn the invaluable lesson of contentment. Seek it as a treasure for your life." He, and you, will be richer for having listened and happier for having learned this biblical truth.
