If you are a football fan it is expected of you to cheer on your team and express your approval when they do well and achieve success on the field. On September 10 come to church ready to cheer like never before as young people take that courageous step of faith and are baptized into the Christian Faith.

It won't be in a river, it won't be cold and Rev. Dan Ketchum was not available so I'll have to do, but it will be just as memorable for our young people.


